A warm welcome to all our stakeholders present here this morning. It is my pleasure to welcome you to this very important session. This is a necessary session with potential to redefine the face of Thabazimbi.

Programme Director, The Thabazimbi Local Municipal Economy faces unacceptably high levels of unemployment. I wish you well as you strategize here today and provide us with a baseline of:

- The current state of tourism

- Thabazimbi Agricultural Show

In this regard, the Municipality will continue to identify mega or signature events, with a tourism impact for hosting or partnerships especially in mining tourism. The aim is to further position the municipality as a business tourism destination.

We do acknowledge that the state of our tourism industry and Thabazimbi's brand recognition is not where we would like it to be.
