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SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT NOTICE

REGISTRATION ON AND UPDATE OF SUPPLIER DATABASE

In terms of the Municipal Supply Chain Regulation 14(1) ii), a municipality must annually invite prospective providers of goods or services to apply for evaluation and listing as accredited prospective providers.

Thabazimbi Local Municipality would like to invite prospective service providers to register on its Procurement Database. Service providers who have already registered their companies in our database, but have not yet renewed their status are encourage to preregister.

The following document should accompany the registration form:

A valid Original Tax Clearance Certificate, certified Company registration Certificate, Certified copies of the ids of shareholders, valid BBBEE rating certificate, company profile, and original or certified copy of municipal rates and taxes Lease Agreement and bank confirmation letter or cancelled cheque.

NB: General Construction, Electricians, Plumbers, Civil works, Consulting and Training Institutions must attach certified accreditation certificates. Service providers are allowed to register a maximum of four (4) categories of services at a time

If one of the above documents is not attached, the municipality reserves the right to not register your company on the Supplier's Database.
